Tasting Notes: It shows an intense purple color with blackish hues. Deep nose of cherries and red fruits. In the palate, a fresh attack showing delicate tannins and aromatic complexity marked by raspberries and blueberries notes. Supple, fresh, and very precise.

Grapes: 100% Malbec

Terroir: Grapes sourced from a 35 year-old vineyard in Souturac, to the west of the appellation. This wine comes from a Terroir micro selection made within the vineyard.

Winemaking: The wine is fermented in stainless steel tanks with natural yeasts and controlled temperature. Maceration for 21 days. Aged in small concrete vats for 12 months.
